1. What products will be available in the Autodesk® Navisworks® 2011 Product Portfolio?

The Autodesk® Navisworks® 2011 Product Portfolio will consist of three products:

- Autodesk® Navisworks® Manage 2011

Navisworks Manage software offers design and construction professionals the most comprehensive project review solution, providing advanced tools for interference analysis and spatial coordination.

- Autodesk® Navisworks® Simulate 2011

Navisworks Simulate software provides comprehensive project review and analysis capabilities to demonstrate design intent and simulation of construction to drive insight and predictability.

- Autodesk® Navisworks® Freedom 2011

Navisworks Freedom software is the free viewer for NWD and 3D DWF files. Navisworks Freedom extends the whole-project view to all project stakeholders, improving communication and collaboration.

2. Is Autodesk® Navisworks® Review part of the Navisworks 2011 Product Portfolio?

Navisworks Review is being retired at launch of the Navisworks 2011 Product Portfolio. All the functionality of Navisworks Review is available in Navisworks Simulate 2011 and Navisworks Manage 2011, therefore customers looking to use that functionality can find it in those products.

3. What changes are being made to Navisworks 2011 Product Portfolio pricing?

4. Why is Autodesk making these changes?

These changes will deliver a simplified Navisworks Product Portfolio that continues to offer a comprehensive set of project review tools to Autodesk customers. Navisworks Simulate becomes the entry-level Navisworks product, offering improved project review features.

5. How will existing Autodesk® Navisworks® Review subscription customers be impacted by these changes?

Navisworks Review 2010 Autodesk Subscription customers will be upgraded to Navisworks Simulate 2011 as part of their subscription entitlement. Subscription customers will be able to access Navisworks 2011 products through the Subscription Centre.

6. How will existing Autodesk® Navisworks® Review non-subscription customers be impacted by these changes?

Navisworks Review non-subscription customers can make use of the Navisworks Review > Navisworks Simulate 2011 cross-grade path to transition to 2011 Navisworks Product Portfolio.

7. How will existing Autodesk suites customers be impacted by these changes?

Suites that include Navisworks Review (such as the AutoCAD® Revit® Architecture Visualization Suite 2010) will include Navisworks Simulate at 2011 launch. Customers will be upgraded to Navisworks Simulate 2011 as part of their Suite subscription entitlement.

8. Was Autodesk® Navisworks® Review subscription and subscription renewals removed from the Q1a pricelist?

Navisworks Review subscriptions and subscription renewals will continue to be available to order until Navisworks Simulate 2011 is released, however the SKU is not on the pricelist. You can reference Q4 price lists for the Navisworks Review subscription SKUs (note: some discount pricing may have changed for Q1, contact your usual Autodesk representative). Navisworks Review subscription and subscription renewal can still be ordered through standard purchasing mechanisms.

9. How do these changes benefit Autodesk® Navisworks® customers?

Customers that are new to Navisworks Simulate 2011 having upgraded from Navisworks Review 2010 will have access to additional tools that will help them to simulate, analyze and review their projects:

TimeLiner

TimeLiner allows customers to link their model geometry to times and dates for 4D simulation. They can import task data from 3rd party scheduling applications to visualize and analyze project sequencing.

Presenter

Presenter allows customers to create photorealistic renderings for export as still images or movies. They can configure materials, lights, backgrounds, and rendering styles to aid in the visual communication of projects.

Animator & Scripter

The Animator and Scripter tools allow customers to animate and interact with project models. They can apply movement to geometry and cameras in the model, and link those animations to events and triggers, including TimeLiner tasks, to simulate real-world behavior.
